ST DAVID'S ADOPTION SERVICE: WHAT WE DO

Recruitment and training: We find and assess people who want to adopt.

Ongoing Support: We provide support before and after adoption, including group meetings, fun events, and special training.

Contact Arrangements: We help with staying in touch with birth families when needed.

Access to Birth Records

- **Information Service:** We help adults access their birth records.
- Intermediary Service: We help connect adopted adults with their birth families if they wish.

Adopting Together Service: We have a unique service for children who have been waiting for a long time for a family or have additional needs. We work with the local authority and regional adoption services to provide this.

WHO WE HELP

Prospective Adopters: People who want to adopt must be 21 or older.

Children: We support children from birth up to 18 years old.

Adopted Adults and Relatives: We help adults who were adopted and their families as well as birth parents looking for their adopted children.

Our Fostering Service

Our fostering service offers bespoke foster carer recruitment, finding and building families for children looked after in Wales. It offers specialist support for children moving placements or moving home to birth family.
